Removing Barriers to Adoptions

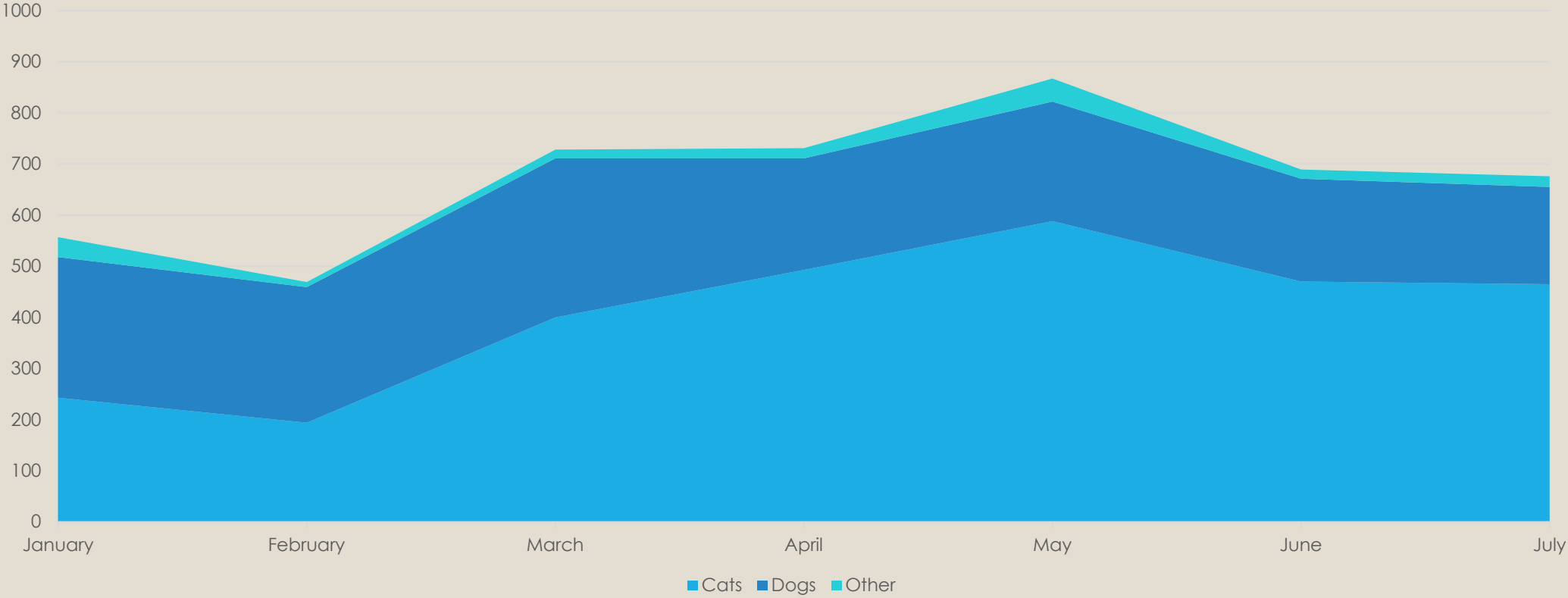
- Increasing the adoption hours by 17%.
 - That's over one extra day's worth of adoptions per week.
- Move from an adoption application to an adoption questionnaire.
 - Removed unneeded questions and focus on matching the adopters.
- Introduced Adopter's Welcome to all staff.
 - Key training already completed.
 - Integrated into onboarding for all staff.
- Reopened the dog adoption kennels to the public.



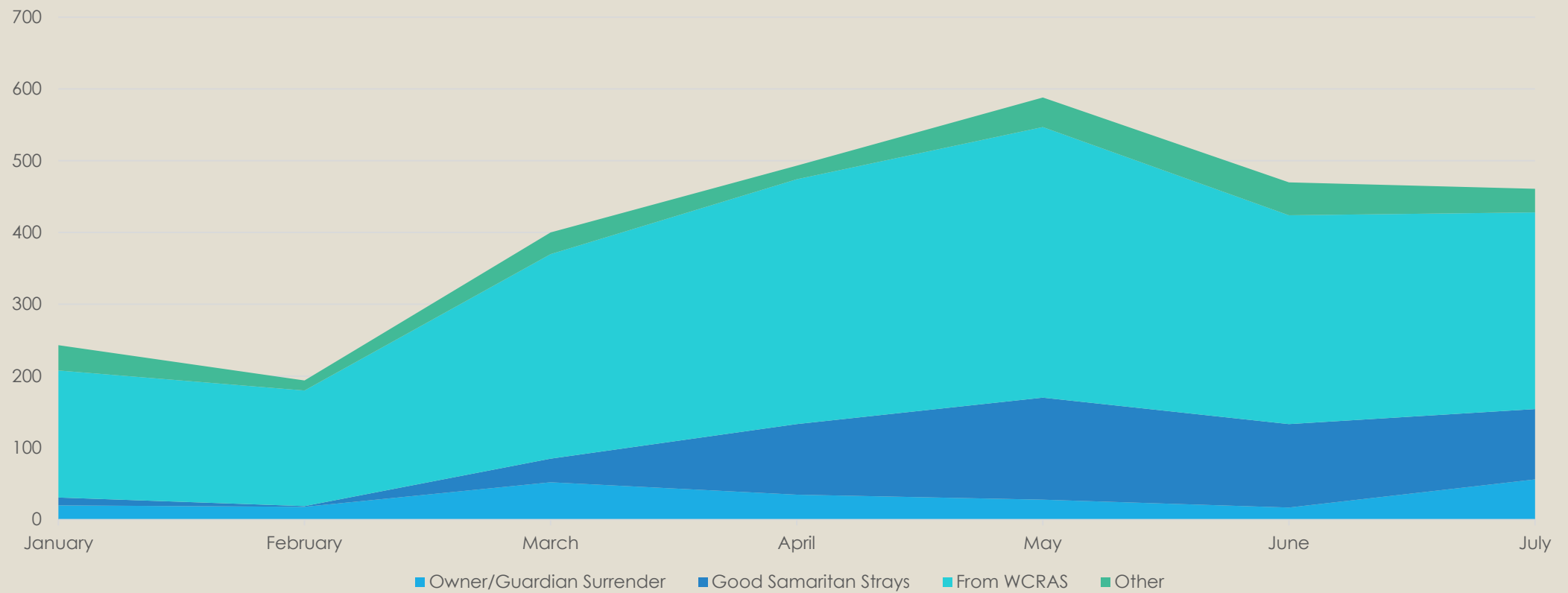
Adoption Kennels Open!

- A reminder, our Carson kennels have been open to the public since early this year.

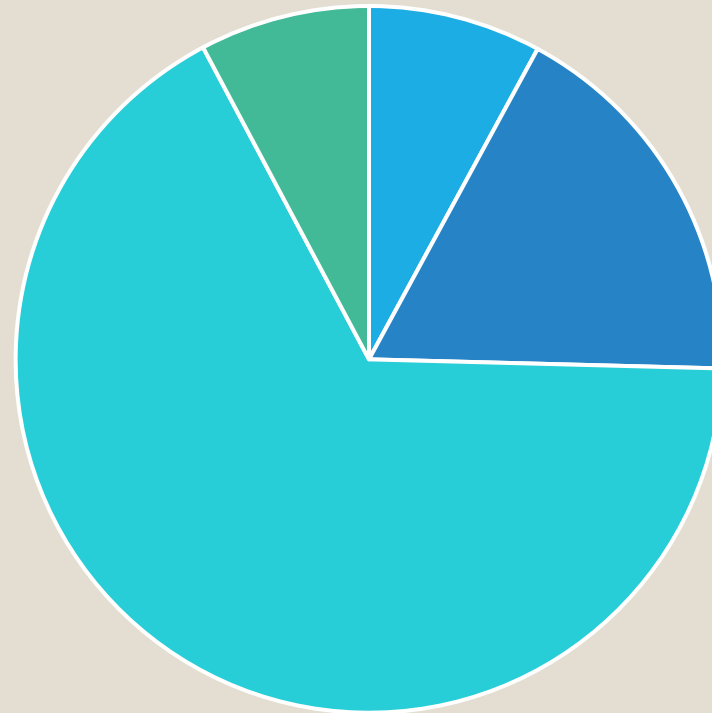
2023 All Intakes(Reno)



2023 Cat Intakes (Reno)

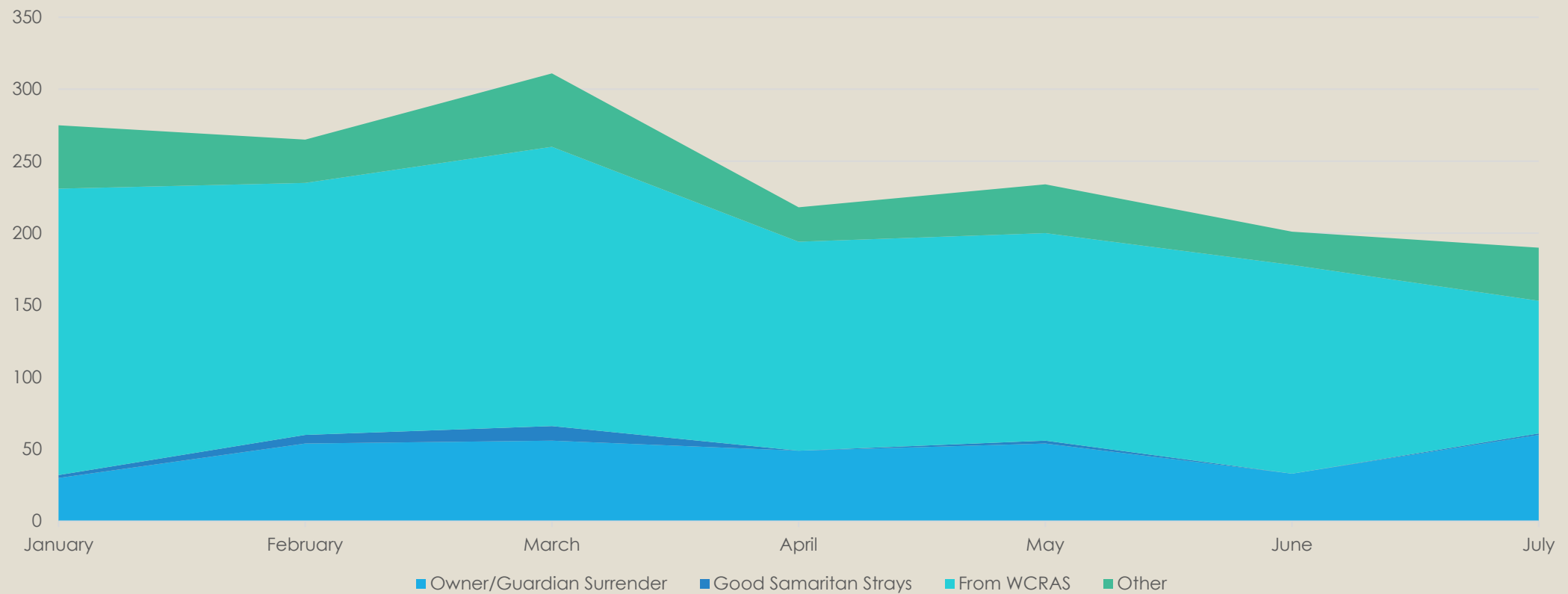

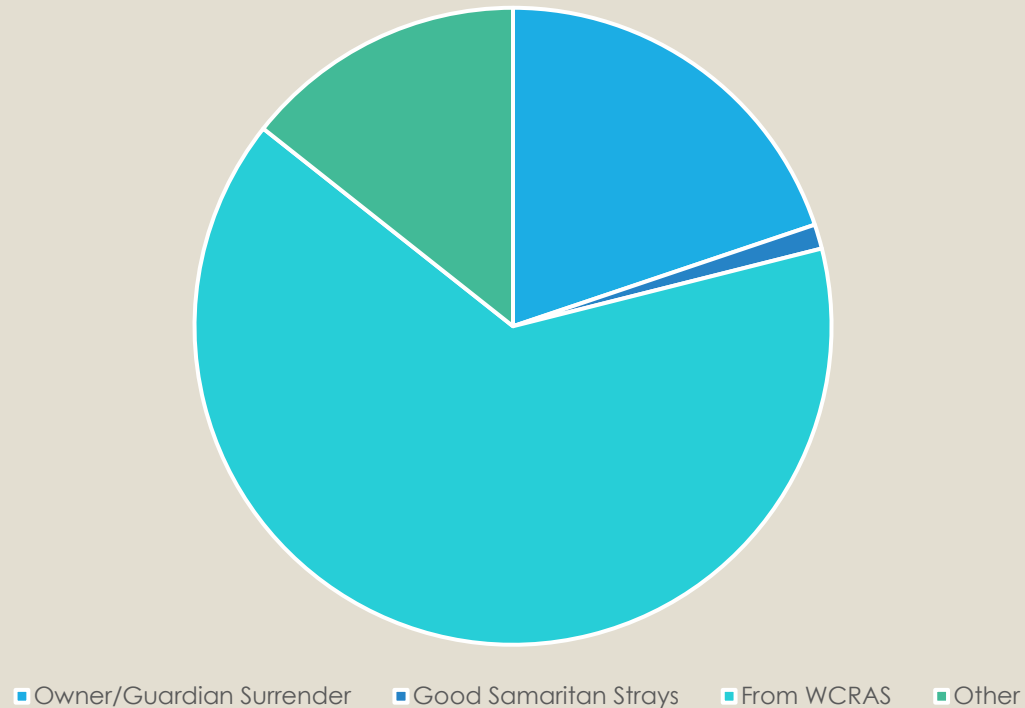

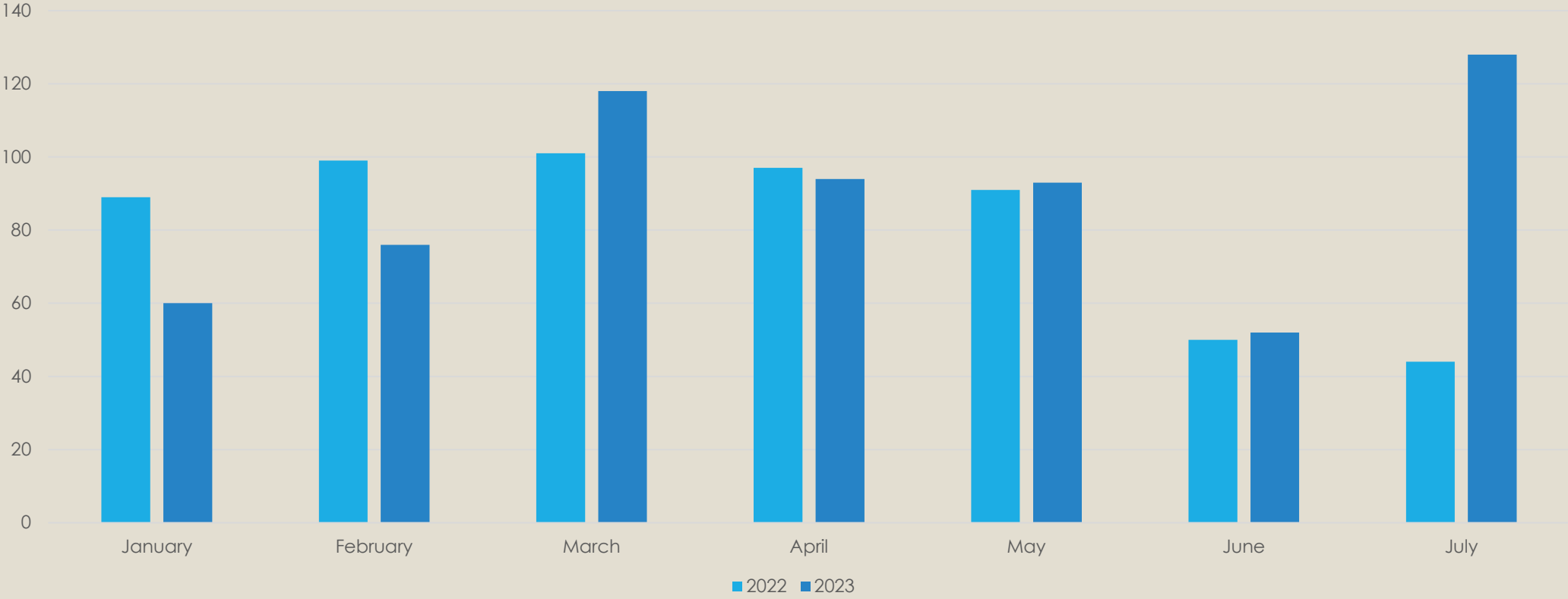

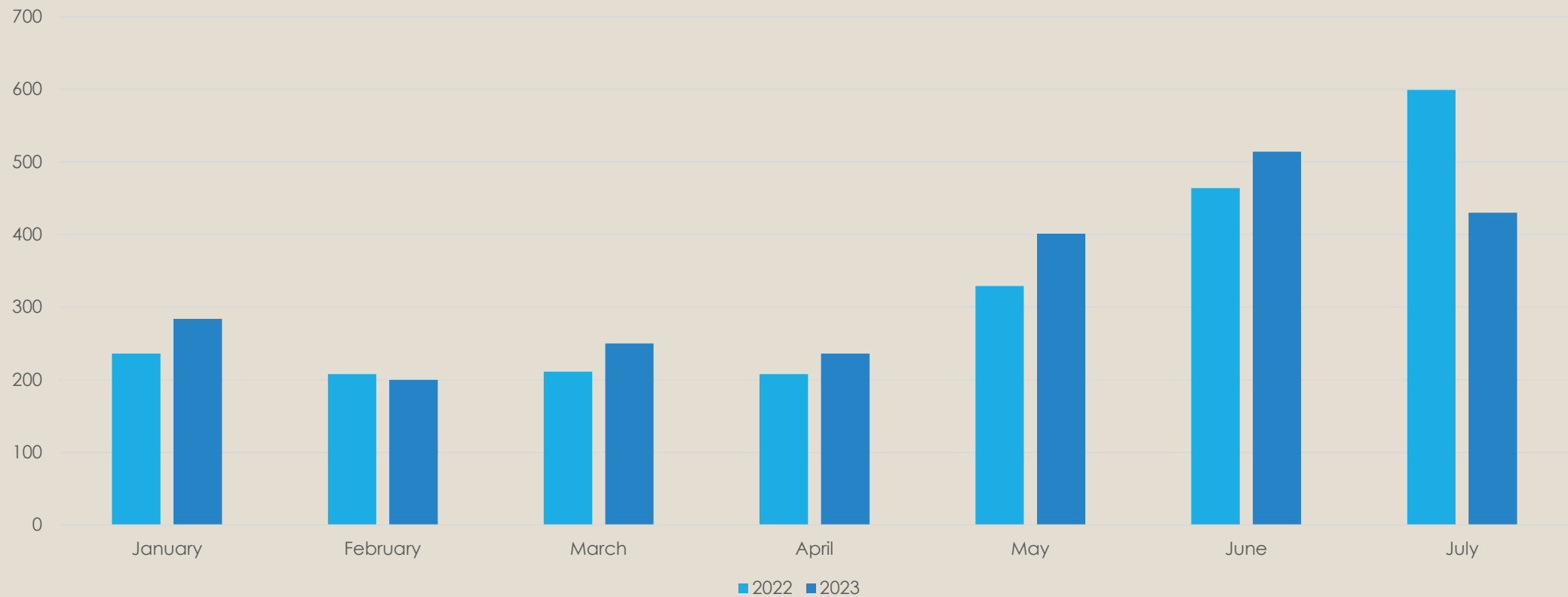
2023 - Dog Intakes (Reno)



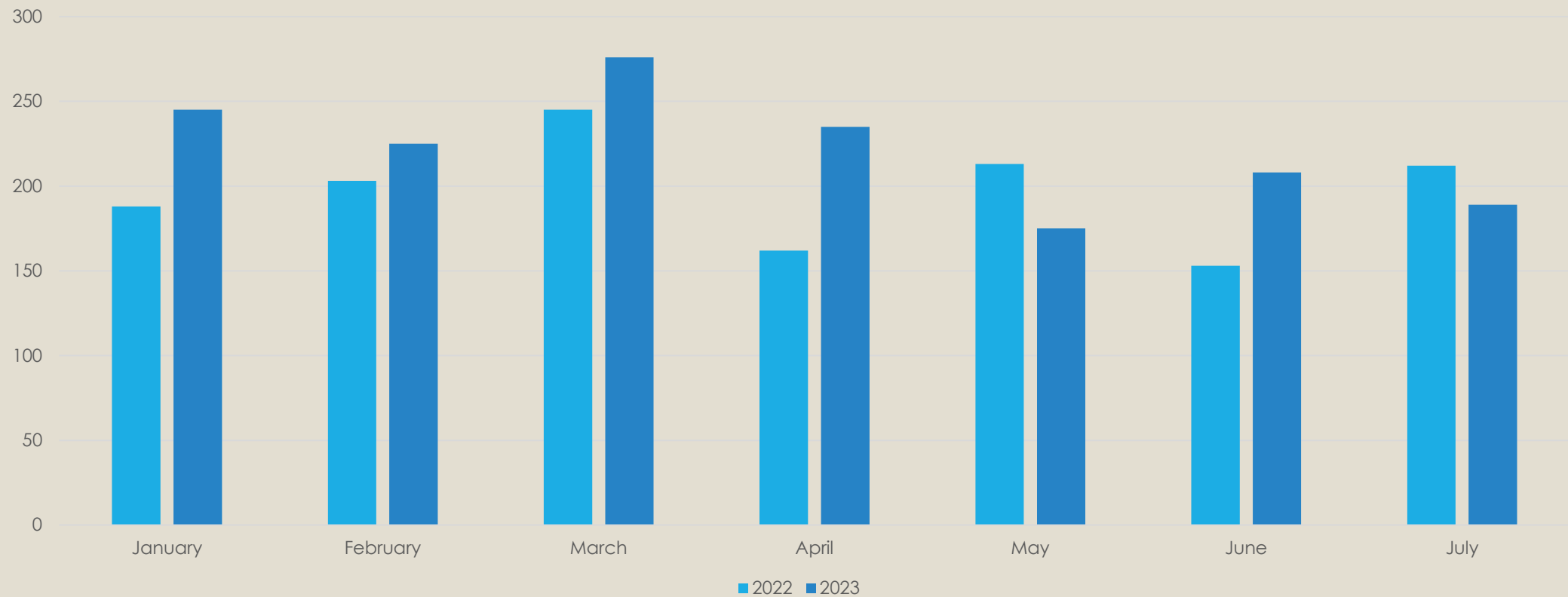
Owner/Guardian Surrenders (Reno)



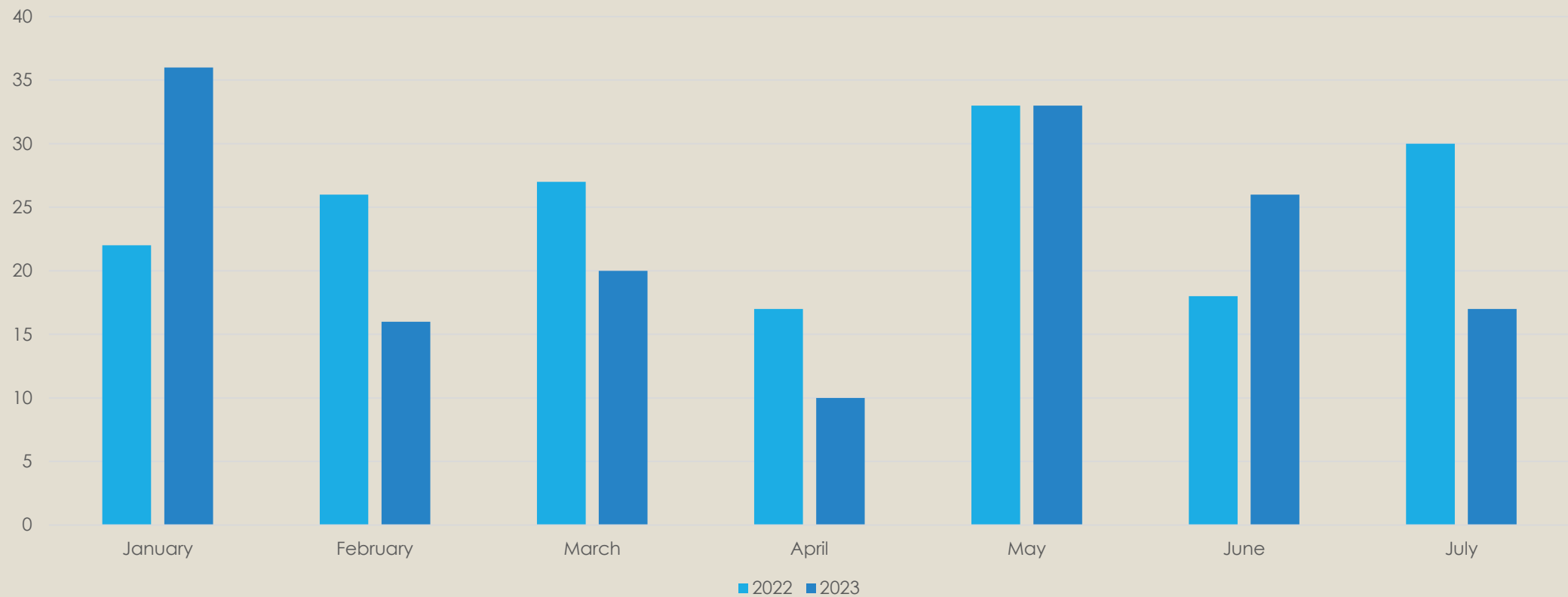
Adoptions – Cats (Reno)



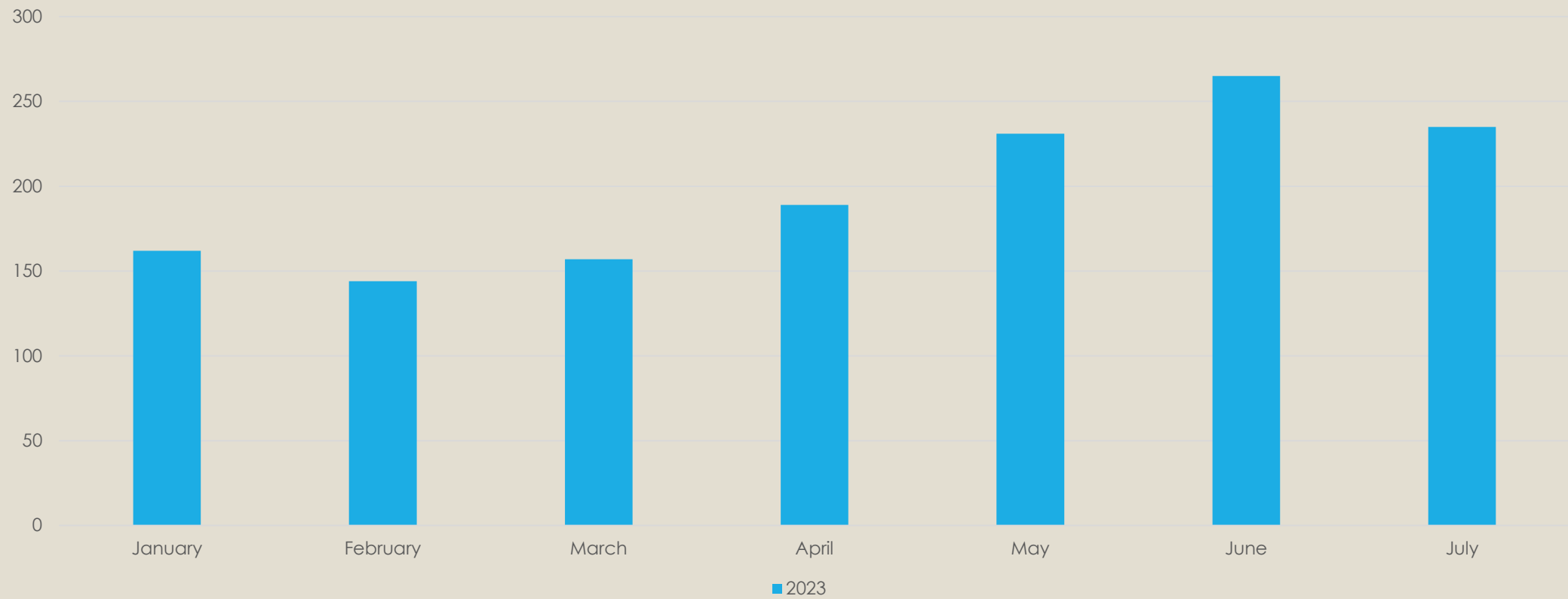
Adoptions – Dogs (Reno)



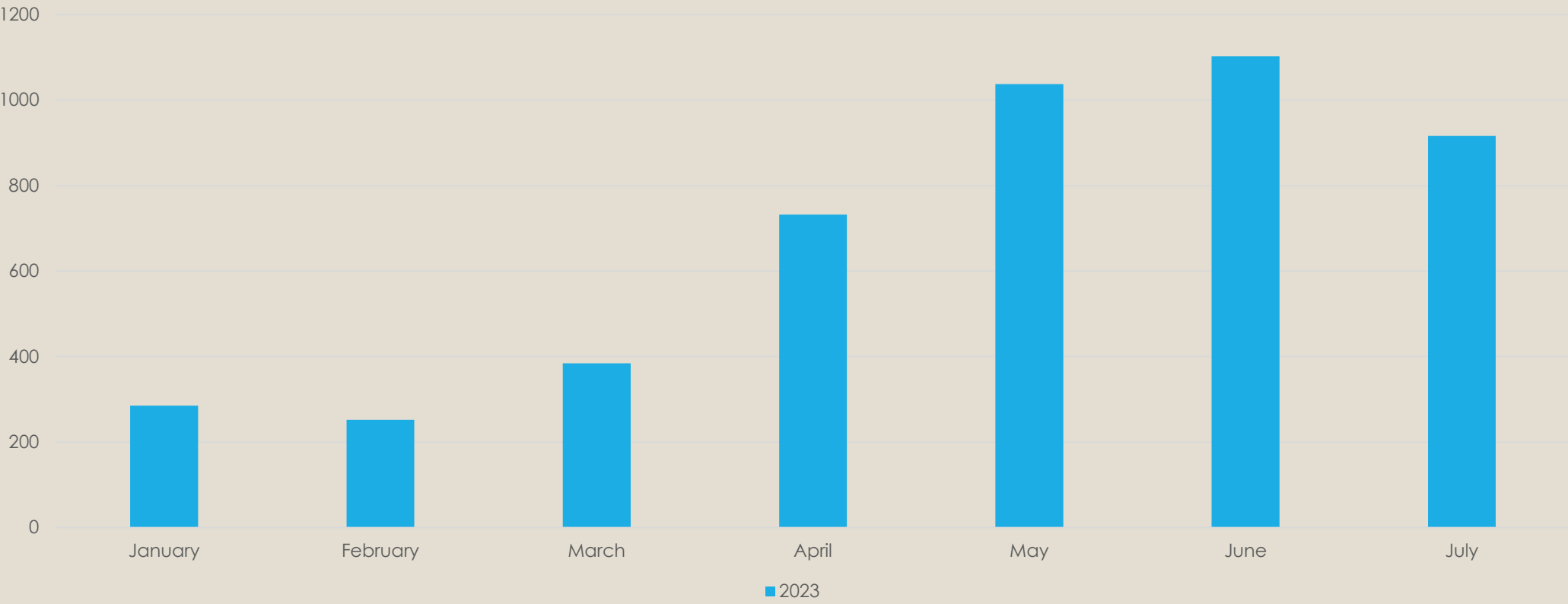
Adoptions – Smalls (Reno)



Active Foster Parents - Reno



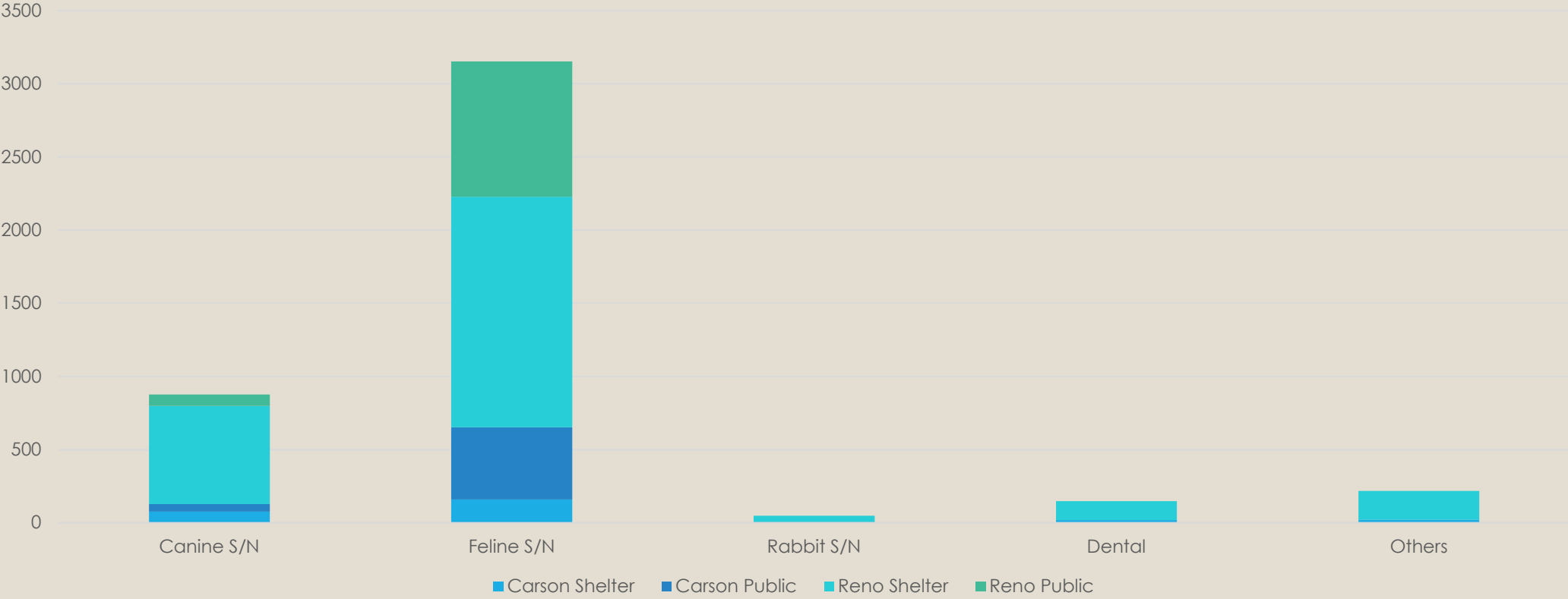
Foster Animals - Reno



Veterinary Clinic Services

- 3 Full Time Veterinarians, with one more starting soon!
- 24 Medical Staff.
- Surgeries for both Reno and Carson 5 days a week.
- Shelter Medicine support 7 days a week at both campuses.

Progress on 90 Day Action Plan

- Adopter's Welcome rolled out to staff
- Fear Free Certification programs rolled out to staff
- Cleaning protocols and procedures updated to support Rescue cleaning product
- Puzzle feeders or enrichment feeding for afternoons
- Daily population wellness rounds with medical and behavior measurements
- Daily pathway planning, with weekly multi-departmental meetings to provide resources to the animals in need.
- Reorganization and restructuring to align staff to our purpose.
- Small animals moved to public areas, with zones for different species.
- Housing improvements to support the 5 Freedoms.
