ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR AND FIX THE TIME FOR TRAPPING OF MUSKRATS IN WASHOE COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA:

By virtue of authority vested in the County Commissioners by an act of the Legislature of the State of Nevada, entitled, "An Act to provide for the protection of muskrats, and to license and regulate the trapping thereof." Approved March 26, 1929. The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, State of Nevada, in regular session met and assembled, do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it shall be lawful for any person to trap or capture muskrats in live traps for the purpose of breeding and propagation of muskrats, at any time during the year of each year hereafter within Washoe County; provided that in trapping or capturing the muskrats that they shall not be killed or wounded in any way or manner.

Moved by Commissioner Doyle and seconded by Commissioner Peckham, and passed and adopted this 5th day of July, 1929, by the following vote of the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, State of Nevada:
