Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 170, Ordinance No. 42, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 AND SECTION 2 TO ADD AN AREA WITHIN WASHOE COUNTY WHEREIN IT IS ILLEGAL FOR CERTAIN ANIMALS TO RUN AT LARGE, OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 42 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANY HORSE, MULE, ASS, KINE, HOG, SHEEP OR GOAT IN THE AREA OF SUN VALLEY VOTING PRECINCT, WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF SAID ANIMALS AS ESTRAYS AND THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN FEES AND COSTS BEFORE THE RELEASE OF SUCH ANIMALS, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR AND VIOLATIONS THEREFORE; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," was proposed on December 5, 1966 by Commissioner Sauer and final action of adoption was taken on December 13, 1966 by the following vote of the Board of County Commissioners:

SUMMARY: An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 42 to add an area within the unincorporated area of Washoe County wherein it is illegal to allow certain animals to run at large.

BILL NO. 170

ORDINANCE NO. 42

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 AND SECTION 2 TO ADD AN AREA WITHIN WASHOE COUNTY WHEREIN IT IS ILLEGAL FOR CERTAIN ANIMALS TO RUN AT LARGE, OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 42 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANY HORSE, MULE, ASS, KINE, HOG, SHEEP OR GOAT IN THE AREA OF SUN VALLEY VOTING PRECINCT, WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF SAID ANIMALS AS ESTRAYS AND THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN FEES AND COSTS BEFORE THE RELEASE OF SUCH ANIMALS, AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR AND VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. County Ordinance No. 42 is hereby amended by adding thereto a Summary to read as follows:

SUMMARY: An ordinance to prevent the running at large of certain animals within certain defined areas of the unincorporated area of Washoe County.

Section 2. County Ordinance No. 42 is hereby amended by changing the title of said Ordinance to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF HORSES, CATTLE, SWINE, GOATS OR SHEEP UPON ANY PORTION OF THE ROADS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN CERTAIN DEFINED DISTRICTS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF SAID ANIMALS AS ESTRAYS AND THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN FEES AND COSTS BEFORE THE RELEASE OF SUCH ANIMALS; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

Section 3. Section 1 of County Ordinance 42 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Certain Animals Running at Large Unlawful.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, having the same in their possession or control, to allow or permit any horse, cattle, swine, goat or sheep to run at large upon any portion of the roads and highways in the area commonly known as Sun Valley Voting Precinct, as that area is currently defined, situated north of the City of Sparks, County of Washoe, State of Nevada.

B. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, having the same in their possession or control, to permit or allow any horse, cattle, swine, goat or sheep to run at large upon any portion of the roads and highways in that area of Washoe County commonly known as Golden Valley and Lemmon Valley and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Sec. 14 T 20 N R 19 E, M.D.B.&M., thence due west to U. S. 395 North, thence in a northwesterly direction along the right of way of U. S. 395 N to a point of intersection with west line of Sec. 8 T 20 N R 19 E, thence north along section lines to the NW Corner of Sec. 8 T 21 N R 19 E thence east along Section lines to the NE Corner of Section 11 T 21 N R 19 E thence south along Section lines to the point of beginning.

Section 4. Section 2 of County Ordinance 42 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Duties of sheriff when impounding estrays.

A. It shall be the duty of the Sheriff of the County of Washoe to impound any and all animals mentioned herein which are found running at large in those areas of Washoe County defined in Section 1 of this Ordinance, and upon the impounding of such animals the sheriff shall post a notice that such animal or animals are in his charge, and if not taken out by the owner or owners, agent or agents, person or persons in charge, by paying all costs, charges, damages and a reasonable amount for the care and keep of such animal or animals, that the same will be sold.

B. After the expiration of 10 days the sheriff having such animal or animals, and having given notice as aforesaid, by posting the notice near the front door of the office of the Sheriff of Washoe County, shall post another written or printed notice at the same place and an additional notice in a conspicuous place in the area where such animal or animals are taken up, describing the same, giving all marks or brands, if any, and stating that such animal or animals will be sold by him to pay the charges, that have, or will accrue against the property, and their costs. The sheriff shall sell to the highest bidder, and upon payment of the purchase money shall turn over to the buyers the animal or animals sold, and after deducting the costs of impounding, and all accrued costs, including the cost of feeding, keeping and selling, shall pay the balance, if any remains, into the county treasury, where it shall become part of the general fund.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100.
