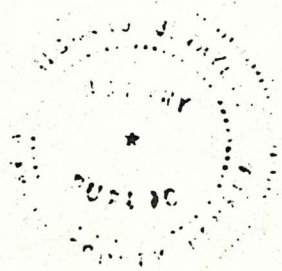

Notice is hereby given that an Ordinance creating a County Department of Welfare, setting up an Advisory Board, defining the duties of the Advisory Board, providing for the appointment of a Welfare Director was proposed on April 27th, 1959 by Commissioner McKenzie, final action of adoption taken on April 27th, 1959, as an emergency measure by the following vote:

4 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF WELFARE; SETTING  
5 UP AN ADVISORY BOARD, DEFINING THE DUTIES OF THE ADVISORY BOARD,  
6 PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A WELFARE DIRECTOR AND DEFINING  
7 THE DUTIES OF THE WELFARE DIRECTOR.

8 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO  
9 ORDAIN:

10 ARTICLE 1 ESTABLISHMENT THEREOF

11 SECTION 1: There is hereby created a County Department of  
12 Welfare which shall consist of the Washoe Board of County  
13 Commissioners; an Advisory Board; a Director of Public Welfare  
14 and such other officers and employees as are hereinafter author-  
15 ized.

16 ARTICLE 2 DEFINITIONS

17 SECTION 1: As used in this Ordinance "Commissioners" shall  
18 mean the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners; "Board"  
19 shall mean the Advisory Board of the Washoe County Department  
20 of Welfare; "Director" shall mean the Director of the Washoe  
21 County Department of Welfare; "Welfare Department" shall mean  
22 the Washoe County Department of Welfare.

23 ARTICLE 3 ADVISORY BOARD

24 SECTION 1: The Advisory Board of the Washoe County Department  
25 of Welfare shall consist of five (5) members appointed by the  
26 Director, with the advice and consent of the Commissioners, on  
27 the basis of broad experience and interest in civic affairs and  
28 matters of public welfare. Their term of office shall be at the  
29 will of the Commissioners. Their services shall be contributed  
30 voluntarily and without any compensation, remuneration, or the  
payment of any expenses which the Board members may incur. The  
Board, at its first meeting shall elect a Chairman from among  
their membership, as well as such other officers of the Board as  
it may, from time to time, deem necessary.

ARTICLE 4 DUTIES OF THE ADVISORY BOARD

SECTION 1: The Board shall:

- A. Keep informed on all activities of the Welfare Department.
- B. Serve as consultants to both the Commissioners and the Director on any matters pertaining to the welfare of the community.
- C. Offer suggestions, criticisms and recommendations to the Commissioners and the Director with regard to the activities of the Department, the Commissioners and/or the Director which are in any way related to the community's welfare problems.



- 1 D. Serve as liaison and as an interpretive body between the  
2 general public, other agencies in the community and the  
Department on matters of common interest.
- 3 E. Meet at least once a month as the Board, at which time the  
4 Director shall be present as a non-voting ex officio member  
of the Board.
- 5 F. Not use or disclose publicly information concerning indivi-  
6 dual applicants or recipients of public assistance. Such  
disclosure or use shall be unlawful and shall constitute a  
7 mis-demeanor.

ARTICLE 5 DUTIES OF THE WELFARE DIRECTOR

8 SECTION 1: A Welfare Director shall be appointed by the  
9 Commissioners, who under the direct supervision of the  
Commissioners, shall discharge all those duties and administer  
10 all such programs as the Commissioners may from time to time  
delegate to the Director. Such duties and administrative  
11 responsibilities shall be restricted to those which under the  
various State laws of Nevada pertaining to welfare matters are  
12 made the responsibility of the counties and which can be lawfully  
delegated by the Boards of County Commissioners to appointed or  
13 elected officials of such counties. The Welfare Director shall  
serve at the will of the Commissioners, and at a salary to be  
14 fixed by them.
