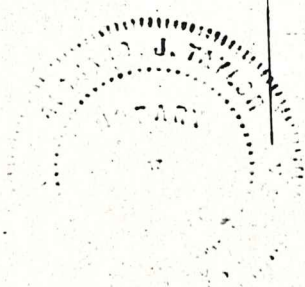

BILL NO. 30

ORDINANCE NO. 71

1 SUMMARY - Provides that loitering in or about school
2 building or grounds or adjoining streets or accesses
3 shall be unlawful unless authorized, and prescribes
4 penalties therefor.

5 AN ORDINANCE OUTLAWING LOITERING IN OR ABOUT SCHOOL
6 GROUNDS WITHOUT PERMISSION, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES
7 FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS RELAT-
8 ING THERETO.

9 THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO
10 ORDAIN:

11 SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful in the County of Washoe:

12 For any person not authorized personnel or not the
13 parent or legal guardian of a pupil in regular attendance at
14 said school to loiter in or about any school building or
15 grounds or in or about adjoining streets and accesses of school
16 grounds without written permission from the principal, custo-
17 dian or other person in charge thereof, or in violation of
18 posted rules or regulations governing the use thereof.

19 SECTION 2: Penalty.

20 Any person who shall violate the provisions of this
21 ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon con-
22 viction thereof shall be fined in the sum of not more than
23 \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term not
24 to exceed six (6) months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

25 SECTION 3: Effective date.

26 This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from
27 and after its passage and approval.
