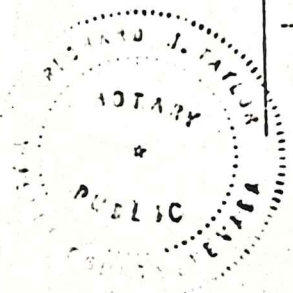

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING LICENSE TAXES FOR REVENUE UPON HOTELS, AND MOTELS OR MOTOR COURTS, BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 69; REQUIRING THE COLLECTION OF SUCH LICENSE TAXES; PRESCRIBING OTHER DETAILS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County of Washoe, in the State of Nevada, has adopted Ordinance No. 69, entitled "An Ordinance Fixing and Imposing License Taxes For Revenue Upon Hotels, And Motels or Motor Courts; Authorizing The Collection Of Such License Taxes; Prescribing Other Details In Connection Therewith; And Declaring An Emergency," passed and adopted on the 7th day of May, 1959; and

WHEREAS, by reason of the inadequacy of county revenues and of the necessity of immediately raising funds, the Board of County Commissioners has determined, and does hereby declare, that an emergency exists requiring this ordinance to take effect from and after its passage and publication by title in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE, IN THE STATE OF NEVADA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 69 be, and the same hereby is, amended by adding two new sections designated as Sections 2.1 and 2.2, to read as follows:

Section 2.1. That each operator be, and hereby is, required to add the amount of the license tax herein fixed and imposed to the amount of the room rentals due thereto, and to collect the tax and rentals from each lessee.

Section 2.2. That each operator shall prominently display in each room or suite of rooms leased as a unit a sign reading substantially as follows:

"NOTICE

"Any operator of hotels, and motels or motor courts for each rental of less than thirty days or one month, whichever is less, is required by law to collect a 5% room tax."

Section 2. That the Board of County Commissioners has expressed in the preamble to this ordinance the existence of an emergency, and does hereby find and declare that such emergency does exist, and, consequently, final action shall be taken immediately, and this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its publication as hereinafter provided, or on September 1, 1959, whichever is later, and that after this ordinance is signed by the Chairman of said Board and attested and sealed by said County Clerk, this ordinance shall be published by title only, together with the names of the commissioners voting for or against its passage, and with a statement that typewritten copies of said ordinance are available for inspection by all interested parties at the office of said County Clerk, in the Reno Evening Gazette, a newspaper published and having general circulation in said County, at least once a week for a period of two weeks by two insertions, pursuant to Section 244.100, Nevada Revised Statutes, and all laws thereunto enabling.
