SUMMARY: Revising Ordinance No. 86 adopting a code prescribing minimum standards for the use, design, installation and maintenance of heating, ventilating, comfort cooling and refrigeration systems and equipment for Washoe County.

BILL NO. 271

ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY BY PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE USE, DESIGN, INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF HEATING, VENTILATING, COMFORT COOLING AND REFRIGERATION SYSTEMS AND EQUIPMENT; REQUIRING A PERMIT AND INSPECTION FOR THE INSTALLATION, ALTERATION AND REPLACEMENT OF SAID EQUIPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SUCH REQUIREMENTS; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

The Uniform Building Code, 1970 Edition, Volume II, "Uniform Mechanical Code," and appendices as jointly approved and published by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials and the International Conference of Building Officials, a copy of which is placed on file in the Office of the County Clerk of Washoe County, Nevada, together with such changes as are necessary to make the same applicable to conditions in the County of Washoe and such other changes as are desirable, which changes are contained in that document marked Exhibit "A", attached hereto, shall be and hereby is adopted by reference, incorporated herein, and made a part hereof, and shall regulate all matters contained therein.

SECTION 2.

That this Ordinance and the Code adopted herein is designed to be compatible with the Uniform Building Code, Volume I, 1970 Edition and Ordinance No. 83. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3.

That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of Volume II of the Uniform Building Code, 1970 Edition, incorporated herein shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and each such person shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense for each and every day or portion thereof during which any violation of any of the provisions of this Code is committed, continued or permitted, and upon conviction of any such violation such person shall be punished by fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both such fine or imprisonment.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as prescribed by NRS 244.105.

EXHIBIT A

1970 EDITION UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE

Whenever the term Administrative Authority is used in the Code it shall be construed to mean the Washoe County Building and Safety Department.

Whenever the term Assistant is used in the Code, it shall be construed to mean the Assistant Building and Safety Inspector employed by the County of Washoe Building and Safety Department.

PART 1 - Administrative

CHAPTER 2 - Organization and Enforcement

SECTION 203 Board of Appeals - add paragraph.
The Building Inspector shall collect a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each notice of appeal which shall be deposited to the credit of the County General Fund.
