Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 325, Ordinance No. 93, entitled "An Ordinance amending Washoe County Ordinance No. 93 by authorizing the Washoe County Sheriff to utilize identification facilities of law-enforcement agencies other than the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and increasing fees for the issuance and renewal of employment certificates and license permits to defray expense of investigation of employees or licensees of gambling houses or establishments where alcoholic beverages are sold at retail; and providing other matters properly relating thereto." was adopted on March 26, 1973, by Commissioners Rusk, Nelson, Pagni, Scott and Grow all voting 5-0.

ORDINANCE NO. 93

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 93 BY AUTHORIZING THE WASHOE COUNTY SHERIFF TO UTILIZE IDENTIFICATION FACILITIES OF LAW-ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES OTHER THAN THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION, AND INCREASING FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF EMPLOYMENT CERTIFICATES AND LICENSEE PERMITS TO DEFRAY EXPENSE OF INVESTIGATION OF EMPLOYEES OR LICENSEES OF GAMBLING HOUSES OR ESTABLISHMENTS WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD AT RETAIL; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Amends Section 3B of Ordinance No. 93 to read as follows:

- B. To take the thumb, fingerprints, and photographs of all applicants and to forthwith send a copy of such imprints to the Identification Division of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at Washington, D. C., or such other law-enforcement agency as the Sheriff may determine, with the request that all information as to the previous record, if any, of such persons be forthwith transmitted to the Washoe County Sheriff. The information, if any, received as aforesaid, shall be treated as confidential and shall only be made accessible to the elective officers of the County, to the employer of such persons where applicable, and to law-enforcement officers.

SECTION 2.

Amends Section 4A of Ordinance No. 93 to read as follows:

- A. Every licensee or employee submitting an application under the provisions of this Ordinance shall first pay to the County of Washoe the sum of Four (\$4.00) Dollars as a condition precedent to having issued to him or her the license or employment certificate, which said sum shall be used to defray the expense of the investigation and shall in any event be retained by the County of Washoe, State of Nevada. Every person seeking a replacement, re-issuance or renewal of an original certificate previously issued to him or her shall pay to the County of Washoe, State of Nevada, the sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars for such replaced or reissued or renewed certificate.

All employment certificates shall be valid for one year and renewable annually provided the applicant shall not become ineligible.

SECTION 3.

Amends Section 4B of Ordinance No. 93 to read as follows:

- B. A person who shall not have been fingerprinted by the Washoe County Sheriff's Department for a period of time of five (5) years shall submit his fingerprints every five (5) years in a similar manner as that provided in Section 3 of this Ordinance, and shall pay the sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars as provided in Section 4B of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
