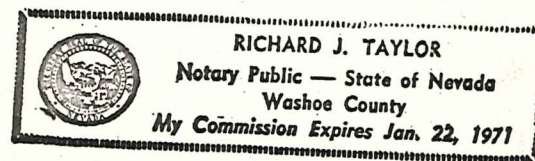

Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 201, an ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 105, Section 6, by deleting therefrom extensions of employment beyond the age of seventy (70), the said Ordinance No. 105 being entitled: "An Ordinance providing local regulations for the establishment of vacation periods, holidays, computation and amount of sick leave and compulsory retirement ages for employees of Washoe County and other matters relating thereto" was proposed on November 6, 1967 by Commissioner Sauer and final action of adoption was taken on November 15, 1967 by the following vote of the Board of County Commissioners:

SUMMARY: An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 105, Section 6, by deleting therefrom extensions of employment beyond the age of seventy (70).

BILL NO. 201

ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 105, SECTION 6, BY DELETING THEREFROM EXTENSIONS OF EMPLOYMENT BEYOND THE AGE OF SEVENTY (70), THE SAID ORDINANCE NO. 105 BEING ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING LOCAL REGULATIONS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VACATION PERIODS, HOLIDAYS, COMPUTATION AND AMOUNT OF SICK LEAVE AND COMPULSORY RETIREMENT AGES FOR EMPLOYEES OF WASHOE COUNTY AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 6 of County Ordinance No. 105, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. Retirement

All regular employees of the County of Washoe shall retire from County service at the end of the current month in which the employee attains the age of sixty-five (65) years. In exceptional circumstances the County Manager may upon recommendation by the department head, in the best interest of the County, extend the retirement age at one-year intervals. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, the granting of such extension by the County Manager shall in no case extend the employee's employment beyond the end of the month in which the employee attains the age of seventy (70). All County of Washoe line personnel employees of the Sheriff's Department actively engaged in police work shall retire at the end of the month upon attaining the age of fifty-five (55) years. In exceptional circumstances the County Manager may upon recommendation by the department head, in the best interest of the County, extend this retirement age in one-year intervals; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the granting of this extension shall in no case exceed the retirement age of sixty (60). No employee of the County of Washoe, as of July 1, 1961, shall be required to retire under the provisions of this section for the period of one year after its adoption, nor shall such current employee be required to retire under the provisions of this section who has less than ten (10) years pensionable service in the Nevada Retirement Service.




Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100.
