SUMMARY: Amends Ordinance No. 117 by specifying the duties and establishing the compensation for Voting Board Chairmen.

BILL NO. 337

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 117 BY SPECIFYING THE DUTIES OF VOTING BOARD CHAIRMEN AND PROVIDING COMPENSATION THEREFOR; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 1 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

Pursuant to the power granted to the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County by NRS 293.460, the compensation of Voting Board Chairmen, Voting Board Officers and specially appointed Deputy Sheriffs who serve on election day is hereby established.

SECTION 2.

Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2.

The compensation to be paid Voting Board Chairmen shall be \$35.00 for all services performed for each election, including but not limited to:

- (a) the selection of two (2) additional Voting Board Officers and one (1) alternate;
- (b) the training in the conduct of elections of two (2) Voting Board Officers and one (1) alternate;
- (c) the pick up and delivery of all election supplies at the direction of the County Clerk; and
- (d) delivery of the official voted ballots to the election computation center at the conclusion of each election.

SECTION 3.

Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3.

The compensation to be paid Voting Board Officers, Counting Board Officers and specially appointed Deputy Sheriffs shall be \$25.00 for all services performed for each election.

SECTION 4.

Section 4 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4.

Regular employees of the County Clerk's Office performing election services before and after regular office hours shall

be allowed to accrue overtime and holiday compensatory time at the same rate as other County employees.

SECTION 5.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
