ORDINANCE NO. 127

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE PAY PLAN AND SALARY SCHEDULE FOR CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES OF WASHOE COUNTY, REVISED EDITION, DATED NOVEMBER 15, 1967, BY AMENDING COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 127, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE ADOPTING A POSITION CLASSIFICATION MANUAL AND A PAY PLAN FOR EMPLOYEES OF WASHOE COUNTY, WHOSE DUTIES AND COMPENSATION ARE NOT PRESCRIBED BY THE CONSTITUTION OR STATUTES OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, CREATING A COUNTY JOB CLASSIFICATION AND SALARY COMMITTEE AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of County Ordinance No. 127 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Pay Plan.

A. Salary Schedule adopted.

1. The Pay Plan for Washoe County employees dated November 15, 1967, and entitled Salary Schedule for Classified Employees, Washoe County, Nevada, dated November 15, 1967, Revised Edition, said Pay Plan figured on the twenty-six (26) Pay Period Plan, and further revised pursuant to resolution of the Board of County Commissioners dated May 6, 1968, is hereby adopted as the Pay Plan and Salary Schedule for employees of Washoe County whose compensation or salaries are not prescribed by the Constitution or the Statutes of the State of Nevada, and the provisions, terms, and salary schedules of said Pay Plan on file in the office of the County Clerk of Washoe County are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as if set out in this Ordinance. (Amended by Bills 135 - 12/65, 171 - 12/66, 202 and 209 - 7/68).

B. Longevity Pay Plan.

1. Any County employee who has reached the highest step in his pay range (Step F) and is therefore not eligible for any annual salary increase shall be allowed a monthly salary increase of 3% of his presently authorized monthly salary on the following conditions:
 - a. No employee shall be eligible for a longevity pay increase unless he has at least four years continuous service with the county.
 - b. No employee shall be eligible for a longevity pay increase if he is otherwise eligible for a salary increase due to change in job classification, promotion to a higher position or such other personnel actions.

c. No employee shall be granted more than three (3) successive longevity pay increases.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1968.




