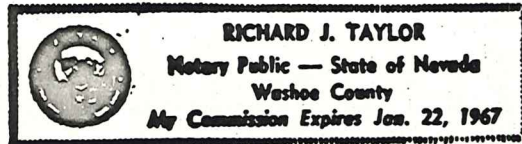

NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 168, Ordinance No. 134, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3 TO REDEFINE A CONGESTED AREA IN THE VICINITY OF VERDI, NEVADA. OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 134 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO DISCHARGE FIREARMS ON OR ACROSS COUNTY ROADS, WITHIN 500 FEET OF A DWELLING IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY AND WITHIN A DEFINED CONGESTED AREA IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY, REQUIRES REASONABLE POSTING BY COUNTY OF CONGESTED AREA IN WHICH DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED; PRESCRIBES PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," was proposed on November 5, 1966 by Commissioner Bauer and final action of adoption was taken on said date as an emergency measure by the following vote of the Board of County Commissioners:

SUMMARY: An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 136 to re-define a congested area within Washoe County in the vicinity of Verdi, Nevada.

BILL NO. 168

ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3 TO RE-DEFINE A CONGESTED AREA IN THE VICINITY OF VERDI, NEVADA, OF COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 136 ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE IT UNLAWFUL TO DISCHARGE FIREARMS ON OR ACROSS COUNTY ROADS, WITHIN 500 FEET OF A DWELLING IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY AND WITHIN A DEFINED CONGESTED AREA IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF THE COUNTY; REQUIRES REASONABLE POSTING BY COUNTY OF CONGESTED AREA IN WHICH DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS PROHIBITED; PRESCRIBES PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Section 3 of County Ordinance 136 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Determination of Congested Areas.

The following described areas within the unincorporated area of Washoe County are hereby determined to be congested areas within the terms of this Ordinance:

1. All that area within the following described boundary within the unincorporated area of Washoe County: Start at the intersection of the City of Reno boundary and Steamboat Ditch in the vicinity of Horseman's Park; thence along Steamboat Ditch to Lone Tree Lane; thence easterly along Lone Tree Lane, Lakeside Drive and Holcomb Lane to the intersection of Holcomb Lane and Thomas Creek Road; thence southerly along Thomas Creek Road to its intersection with Foothill Road; thence easterly and north-easterly along Foothill Road to its intersection with U. S. 395 South; thence northerly along U. S. 395 South to Longley Lane; thence north-easterly along Longley Lane and Boynton Lane to Pembroke Drive; thence easterly on Pembroke Drive to the Steamboat Creek; thence northeasterly along Steamboat Creek to the Truckee River; thence westerly along the Truckee River to the east boundary of the City of Reno in the vicinity of Kietzke Lane; thence southeasterly, southerly and westerly along the City of Reno boundary line to the point of beginning.
2. All that area within the following described boundary within the unincorporated area of Washoe County: Start at the intersection of the Nevada-California State Line and the Truckee River; thence

northeasterly and northerly and downstream along the Truckee River to the point of diversion of the Sierra Pacific Power Company Canal; thence northerly and downstream along the Canal to the South Verdi Road; thence northerly and northeasterly along the South Verdi Road to Bridge Street; thence northwesterly along Bridge Street to Second Street; thence easterly along Second Street to the old U. S. Highway 40; thence easterly along the old U. S. Highway 40 to the Truckee River; thence northwesterly and upstream along the Truckee River to the mouth of the Verdi Substation discharge channel, further described as being the end of the Sierra Pacific Power Company Canal; thence westerly and upstream along the discharge channel, the penstock, flume and channel of the Canal to Bridge Street; thence northwesterly along Bridge Street to the Truckee River; thence southwesterly and upstream along the Truckee River to the mouth of Dog Creek located approximately one-half mile northwesterly of Verdi; thence northwesterly and westerly along Dog Creek to its intersection with the Nevada-California State Line; thence southerly along the Nevada-California State Line to the point of beginning.

3. Beginning at the intersection of the Mt. Rose Highway, Nevada State Highway 27, and Callahan Road; thence southerly along Callahan Road to its intersection with Galena Creek; thence easterly and downstream along Galena Creek to the Sierra Pacific Power Company Washoe to Carson City 'H' frame power transmission line; thence southerly along the transmission line to the old Callahan road; thence westerly and northerly along the old Callahan road to a primary private road running westerly in the vicinity of the Galena Volunteer Fire Department and the former Galena Creek School site; thence westerly and southerly along the primary private road to its intersection near Brown's Creek with a Forest Service road, which extends from Washoe City to the old Boy Scout Camp; thence northerly and northwesterly along the Forest Service road to its intersection with Galena Creek; thence westerly and upstream along Galena Creek to its intersection with the Mt. Rose Highway; thence northerly and northeasterly along the Mt. Rose Highway to its intersection with Callahan Road, the place of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS §244.100.
