AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 162, BILL NO. 217, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF U.S. HIGHWAY 395 SOUTH FROM 150 FEET SOUTH OF DEL MONTE LANE TO 300 FEET SOUTH OF PREMISES COMMONLY DESCRIBED AS 6335 SOUTH VIRGINIA STREET".

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 162, Bill No. 217, is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.


