SUMMARY: Organizes Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District; describes boundaries thereof; authorizes contracts between county and district.

ORDINANCE NO. 188

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ORGANIZING THE TRUCKEE MEADOWS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT; DESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF AND THE TERRITORY INCLUDED THEREIN; AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS BETWEEN THE DISTRICT AND WASHOE COUNTY; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Organization, name of district. Pursuant to the authority contained in NRS 474.460 in order to provide for the prevention and extinguishment of fires there is hereby created and organized in Washoe County, Nevada, a fire protection district, the boundaries of which are described in Section 2 of this ordinance, which is named and shall be known as the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District.

SECTION 2. Boundaries of district; excepted areas. The boundaries of the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District are described as follows:

Commence at the point of intersection of the California-Nevada state line and the north line of T.22N., M. D. B. & M., the true point of beginning; thence easterly along the north line of T.22N., M. D. B. & M., to a point of intersection with the county boundary line common to Washoe County and Churchill County; thence southwesterly along the county boundary line to a monument common to Washoe County, Churchill County and Lyon County; thence southwesterly and westerly along the county boundary line common to Washoe County and Lyon County to a point on the easterly county boundary line of Storey County; thence northeasterly, northwesterly, southwesterly along the boundary line common to Washoe County and Storey County to a county boundary monument common to Washoe County, Storey County, Lyon County and Carson City; thence southwesterly along the county boundary line common to Washoe County and Carson City to the intersection with the California-Nevada state line; thence northerly along the state line to the true point of beginning, excepting therefrom the territory included in:

1. The incorporated areas of the cities of Reno and Sparks.
2. Fire protection districts formed and existing in accordance with the provisions of chapter 473 of NRS or NRS 474.010 to 474.450, inclusive.

SECTION 3. Contracts between county and district. Pursuant to the provisions of NRS 474.475, the Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, Nevada, hereby authorizes the execution of contracts between Washoe County and the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District for the prevention and control of fires and concerning the exercise of the powers provided in NRS 474.470.

SECTION 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
