SUMMARY: Amends the Uniform Fire Code by providing that all permits for open burning shall be issued by the Control Officer of the Washoe County District Health Department, or his designee.

ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 193, THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE, BY SUBORDINATING THE PROVISIONS OF THE UNIFORM FIRE CODE RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE AND ENFORCEMENT OF BURNING PERMITS FOR OPEN FIRES TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE WASHOE COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR OPEN BURNING BY THE CONTROL OFFICER OF THE WASHOE COUNTY DISTRICT HEALTH DEPARTMENT, OR HIS DESIGNEE; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 1.202 of Ordinance No. 193, the 1971 Edition of the Uniform Fire Code, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1.202 (a) The Chief, with the approval of the Administrator, is authorized to make and enforce such rules and regulations for the prevention and control of fires and fire hazards as may be necessary from time to time to carry out the intent of this Code. Three certified copies of such rules and regulations shall be filed with the Clerk of the jurisdiction and shall be in effect immediately thereafter and additional copies shall be kept in the office of the Fire Department for distribution to the public.

(b) The Washoe County Air Pollution Control Regulations shall take precedence over those provisions of the Uniform Fire Code, Ordinance No. 193, that relate to the issuance and enforcement of burning permits for open fires. All permits for open burning shall be issued by the Control Officer of the Washoe County District Health Department, or his designee, pursuant to said Air Pollution Regulations.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
