Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 340, Ordinance No. 211, entitled "An Ordinance prohibiting the placement of street name signs on private roads without prior approval of the County Engineer; provides for removal of illegal street name signs at the expense of the person erecting such signs; providing penalties for the violation thereof; and providing other matters properly relating thereto," was adopted on September 3, 1973, by Commissioners Rusk, Scott, Pagni, Nelson and Gray all voting aye.

SUMMARY: Prohibits placement of street name signs on private roads without prior approval of the County Engineer.

BILL NO. 340

ORDINANCE NO. 211

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PLACEMENT OF STREET NAME SIGNS ON PRIVATE ROADS WITHOUT PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY ENGINEER; PROVIDES FOR REMOVAL OF ILLEGAL STREET NAME SIGNS AT THE EXPENSE OF THE PERSON ERECTING SUCH SIGNS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.
In order to prevent duplication of street names or pronounciations, no person, firm, business, association, or corporation, shall erect or emplace a street name sign on any private road in the unincorporated area of Washoe County without first obtaining the approval of the proposed street name from the County Engineer.


SECTION 2.
Any street name sign erected or emplaced in violation of this Ordinance may be removed by Washoe County, and Washoe County shall be entitled to recover all costs of removal from the person, firm, business, association or corporation causing such street name sign to be erected or emplaced.



SECTION 3.
Any person, firm, business, association or corporation, who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in the sum of \$500.00. Each sign erected or emplaced in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4.
This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
