SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 212 by designating primary and secondary truck routes within the Washoe Lake Basin.

ORDINANCE NO. 212

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WASHOE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 212 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PRIMARY AND SECONDARY TRUCK ROUTES WITHIN WASHOE COUNTY."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 212 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Designated Primary Truck Routes.

A. Lake Tahoe - Incline Village and Crystal Bay

1. State Route 27 in its entirety.
2. State Route 28 in its entirety.

B. Washoe Lake Basin

1. U. S. Highway 395 in its entirety.
2. FAS 822, that portion lying in the basin.
3. FAS 823 in its entirety.

SECTION 2.

Section 4 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 212 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Designated Secondary Truck Routes.

A. Lake Tahoe - Incline Village and Crystal Bay

1. Calaneva Drive in its entirety.
2. Country Club Drive from State Route 28 to Lakeshore Boulevard.
3. East Enterprise in its entirety.
4. Incline Way in its entirety.
5. Lakeshore Boulevard from Village Boulevard to Country Club Drive.
6. Mayes Boulevard from West End Shopping Center to Southwood Boulevard.
7. North Enterprise in its entirety.
8. Oriole Way in its entirety.
9. Parvin Road in its entirety.
10. Reservoir Drive from Wassou Road to State Route 28.
11. Southwood Boulevard in its entirety.
12. State Line Road from Wassou Road to Entrance--Cal Neva Lodge.
13. Sweetwater Road from State Route 28 to Parvin Road.
14. Tanager Street in its entirety.
15. Village Boulevard from State Route 28 to Lakeshore Boulevard.
16. Wassou Road from State Line Road to Reservoir Drive.

B. Washoe Lake Basin

1. East Lake Boulevard in its entirety.
2. FAS 709 in its entirety.


SECTION 3.
