AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 230, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF COURT ADMINISTRATOR IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DISTRICT JUDGES; PROVIDING FOR HIS DESIGNATION; SPECIFICALLY ASSIGNING CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS EMPLOYED IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT TO THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF THE DISTRICT JUDGES AND THE COURT ADMINISTRATOR; PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES OF THE COURT ADMINISTRATOR; MAKING PROVISION FOR NECESSARY APPROPRIATION TRANSFERS AFFECTING DISTRICT COURT AND COUNTY CLERK'S BUDGETS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO."

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. Subsection A of section 1 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 230 is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Recognize the power of the judiciary by assigning certain employees in the office of the Clerk of the District Court and in the Washoe County Law Library to the Judicial Branch of government under complete jurisdiction and control of the District Judges, and designating the status of such employees as exempt employees, pursuant to subparagraph (1) of paragraph (d) of subsection 2 of section 20 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 213.

Sec. 2. Section 4 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 230 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. A. Effective on June 21, 1974, the following named individuals are assigned as exempt employees of the District Judges:

- B. Upon the effective date of this amendatory ordinance, all employees of the Washoe County Law Library are assigned as exempt employees of the District Judges.
- C. From the effective date of this amendatory ordinance, transfers from the jurisdiction of the District Judges to employment with various other departments of county government shall be accomplished by the use of standard Washoe County personnel action forms officially in use by the District Judges or by county departments which are under the direction of the Washoe County Personnel Department.
- Sec. 3. Section 6 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 230 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 6. The County Manager is directed to take necessary action to adjust the budgets of the District Judges and the county departments affected by the provisions of this Ordinance for the appropriate fiscal years in order to effectuate the purposes of this ordinance.

Sec. 4. The title of Washoe County Ordinance No. 230 is hereby amended to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF COURT ADMINISTRATOR IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DISTRICT JUDGES; PROVIDING FOR HIS DESIGNATION; SPECIFICALLY ASSIGNING CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS EMPLOYED

IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE DISTRICT COURT AND THE WASHOE COUNTY LAW LIBRARY TO THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF THE DISTRICT JUDGES AND THE COURT ADMINISTRATOR; PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES OF THE COURT ADMINISTRATOR; MAKING PROVISION FOR NECESSARY BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
