SUMMARY: Amends Washoe County Ordinance No. 51 to provide that street lighting at certain intersections in subdivisions shall be the financial responsibility of the subdivider.

BILL NO. 455

ORDINANCE NO. 291

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING LOCAL REGULATIONS FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF LAND WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR THE REVIEW OF TENTATIVE PLATS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Paragraph A of Section 5 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 51 is hereby amended by the addition of the following data requirement to be designated as Number 17.

- 17. Locations of proposed street lights. (See Section 6, Paragraph K.)

SECTION 2.

Section 6 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 51 is hereby amended by the addition of the following paragraph to be designated Paragraph K.

- K. Street lights will be required for major street intersections or hazardous street intersections. Major street intersections are those intersections having at least one intersecting street with a minimum designated vehicular speed limit of 45 miles per hour. Hazardous intersections are those intersections determined to be hazardous by the Washoe County Traffic Control Committee because of detrimental physical characteristics. All street lighting shall be luminaires in accordance with local utility standards, with either 7,000 lumens or 20,000 lumens, whichever shall be determined to be required by the Washoe County Engineer. Light poles shall be either wooden or metal, whichever shall be determined to be required by the Washoe County Engineer.

SECTION 3.

Paragraph A of Section 10 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 51 is hereby amended by the addition of the following sentences:

The street lighting installation shall be the financial responsibility of the subdivider. He shall make all necessary arrangements with the utility company involved for the installation of such street lights as are approved and required by Washoe County.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
