Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 457, Ordinance No. 293, amending Ordinance No. 193, entitled "An Ordinance amending an Ordinance of the County of Washoe providing minimum standards to safeguard life, health, property and public welfare by regulating the storage, use and handling of dangerous and hazardous materials, substances, devices and processes, by regulating the maintenance of buildings and equipment, by providing for weed abatement and control, by providing for the administration and enforcement of such requirements, prescribing penalties for violations thereof, and other matters properly relating thereto," was adopted on November 17, 1975 by Commissioners Scott, Rusk, Nelson and Gaunt all voting aye, Commissioner Grow being absent.

ORDINANCE NO. 293

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE PROVIDING MINIMUM STANDARDS TO SAFEGUARD LIFE, HEALTH, PROPERTY AND PUBLIC WELFARE BY REGULATING THE STORAGE, USE AND HANDLING OF DANGEROUS AND HAZARDOUS MATERIALS, SUBSTANCES, DEVICES AND PROCESSES, BY REGULATING THE MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS AND EQUIPMENT, BY PROVIDING FOR WEED ABATEMENT AND CONTROL, BY PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF SUCH REQUIREMENTS, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Exhibit A to Washoe County Ordinance No. 193 is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (g) from Section 13.301 of said exhibit.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.


