ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, PROPERTY AND SAFETY OF THE CITIZENS OF WASHOE COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, BY REGULATING TRAFFIC; PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARD REQUIREMENTS IN REGARD TO TRAFFIC SUPPLEMENTARY TO STATE LAW; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

That attachment to Washoe County Ordinance No. 143 entitled "Restricted Speed Zones in the Unincorporated Area of Washoe County" is hereby amended with respect to restricted speeds in the Verdi area to read as follows:

SECTION 2.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
