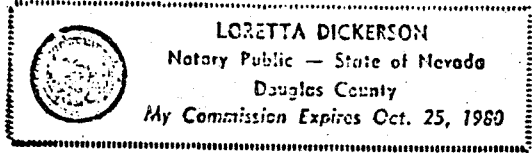

ORDINANCE NO. 350

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH, PROPERTY AND SAFETY OF THE CITIZENS OF WASHOE COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, BY REGULATING TRAFFIC; PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARD REQUIREMENTS IN REGARD TO TRAFFIC SUPPLEMENTARY TO STATE LAW; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO, AND REPEALING ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith" BY AMENDING SECTION 4(E), SUBPARAGRAPH 3(a) AND THE ATTACHED LIST OF "RESTRICTED SPEED ZONES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY" WITH RESPECT TO LAKE TAHOE-INCLINE VILLAGE AND LAKE TAHOE-CRYSTAL BAY.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.  
Section 4(E), Subparagraph 3(a) of Washoe County Ordinance No. 143 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3. Restricted Speed Zones.

(a) In order to protect life, limb, and property, and to facilitate the orderly movement of vehicular traffic upon the streets and highways in the unincorporated area of the County, the Board of County Commissioners may establish restricted speed zones, which shall be noted on the list attached to this Ordinance entitled '\*RESTRICTED SPEED ZONES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY'. Said list is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit 'A' and is incorporated herein by reference as if set forth in full. The Sheriff of Washoe County shall cause to be placed upon the street or highway where any restricted speed zone has been established as indicated on the aforesaid list attached hereto as Exhibit 'A' appropriate signs or signals giving notice thereof.

(b) [no change]. . . ."

SECTION 2.  
Exhibit "A", entitled "\*RESTRICTED SPEED ZONES IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY", which shall be attached to Washoe County Ordinance No. 143 as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference shall read as appears on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, which is incorporated herein as if set forth in full.

SECTION 3.  
This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.

\*RESTRICTED SPEED ZONES  
IN THE  
UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY

Pursuant to Section 4(E) 3 of County Ordinance No. 143, the following restricted speed zones are established for the unincorporated area of Washoe County, and the Sheriff of Washoe County and the County Engineer are directed to cause to be placed upon the following streets and highways appropriate signs giving notice of the restricted speed zones.

LAKE TAHOE - INCLINE

All public streets, roads, and highways within the exterior boundaries of the Incline Village General Improvement District as created by Washoe County Ordinance No. 97, excepting therefrom any State highways with said exterior boundaries and Country Club Drive from the Mount Rose Highway (Nevada State Route 27) to its intersection with Nevada State Route 28.....25 MPH  
COUNTRY CLUB DRIVE FROM MOUNT ROSE HIGHWAY (Nevada State Route 27) TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH NEVADA STATE ROUTE 28.....35 MPH  
NORTHWOOD AND SOUTHWOOD BLVD. FROM COTTONWOOD DR. TO LAKE VIEW SHOPPING CENTER (during school hours).....15 MPH
