SUMMARY: Provides that furnishing or attempting to furnish false information in order to obtain lodging in any commercial place of temporary abode shall be unlawful.

BILL NO. 522

ORDINANCE NO. 354

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO FURNISH OR ATTEMPT TO FURNISH FALSE INFORMATION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN LODGING IN ANY COMMERCIAL PLACE OF TEMPORARY ABODE; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

It is unlawful for any person, either for himself or representing others, to furnish or attempt to furnish any information known by said person to be false, including but not limited to name, address, vehicle information, number of occupants, payment information, firm represented or any other information required by said establishment, in order to secure lodging in any motel, hotel, inn, recreation vehicle park or any other commercial place of temporary abode in the unincorporated area of Washoe County.

SECTION 2.

It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any person who occupies any room or other such space in any commercial place of temporary abode when he knows such room or other such space to have been obtained by false information.

SECTION 3.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the Washoe County Jail for a period of not more than six (6) months or by both fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
