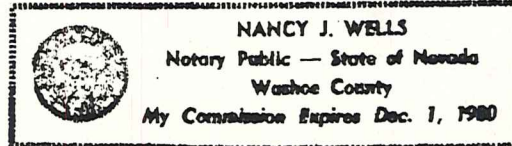

NOTICE OF COUNTY ORDINANCE
Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 561, Ordinance No. 393, amending Ordinance No. 229, entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF COUNTY PARK SYSTEM FACILITIES; DESIGNATING THE WASHOE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO ADMINISTER THE SYSTEM; PERMITTING PROMULGATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS TO SUPPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF FEES; PROVIDING PROHIBITIONS AND A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO," BY CHANGING THE TIME LIMITS ON CAMPING WITHIN COUNTY PARK SYSTEM, was adopted on August 1, 1978 by Commissioners Buck Nelson, Ferr, Sloves and Brown. ORDINANCE NO. 393

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF COUNTY PARK SYSTEM FACILITIES; DESIGNATING THE WASHOE COUNTY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO ADMINISTER THE SYSTEM; PERMITTING PROMULGATION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS TO SUPPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF FEES; PROVIDING PROHIBITIONS AND A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY CHANGING THE TIME LIMITS ON CAMPING WITHIN COUNTY PARK SYSTEM.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1.

Section 31 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 229 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 31. Time limits on camping.

In order to afford the general public the greatest possible use of all county parks, no person or persons or any personal property of such person or persons may continually occupy any county park for more than 7 days within any 30-day period, unless written permission has been granted by the Director of the Washoe County Parks and Recreation Department.

SECTION 2.

This ordinance shall take effect after its proposal, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
