Notice is hereby given that Bill No. 571, Ordinance No. 403, entitled, "An ordinance amending an ordinance specifying certain duties of Voting Board Chairmen, setting the compensation for Voting Board Chairmen, Voting Board Officers, Counting Board Officers and specially appointed Deputy Sheriffs during an election; and providing that accrued overtime and holiday compensatory time shall be allowed for regular employees of the County Clerk's Office at the same rate as for other County employees by amending the title thereof; and specifying the amount of compensation to be paid to certain election board officers." was adopted on November 7, 1978 by Commissioners Rusk, Farr, Brown, Stoess and Nelson. ORDINANCE NO. 403

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE SPECIFYING CERTAIN DUTIES OF VOTING BOARD CHAIRMEN, SETTING THE COMPENSATIONS FOR VOTING BOARD CHAIRMEN, VOTING BOARD OFFICERS, COUNTING BOARD OFFICERS AND SPECIALLY APPOINTED DEPUTY SHERIFFS DURING AN ELECTION; AND PROVIDING THAT ACCURED OVERTIME AND HOLIDAY COMPENSATORY TIME SHALL BE ALLOWED FOR REGULAR EMPLOYEES OF THE COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE AT THE SAME RATE AS FOR OTHER COUNTY EMPLOYEES" BY AMENDING THE TITLE THEREOF; AND SPECIFYING THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO CERTAIN ELECTION BOARD OFFICERS.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The title of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AMOUNT OF COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO CERTAIN ELECTION BOARD OFFICERS.

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 1. Except as provided in subsection 2:
 - (a) Foremen and voting board chairmen shall each receive \$50 for all services performed at each election.
 - (b) Other election board workers shall each receive:
 - (1) \$40 if they perform services for 8 hours or more at each election; or
 - (2) \$5 for each hour or fraction thereof that they perform services for less than 8 hours at each election, but in no event may they receive less than \$25 for such services.

- 2. Any person who:
 - (a) Is employed by, and on the regular payroll of, the registrar of voters; and
 - (b) Performs services as an election board officer at any election; shall receive his usual compensation as such an employee in lieu of the compensation specified in subsection 1.

SECTION 3. Section 3 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 117 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after its proposal, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.


