AN ORDINANCE AMENDING "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND INOCULATION AGAINST RABIES OF DOGS IN DESIGNATED CONGESTED AREAS OF THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF WASHOE COUNTY; PROVIDES FOR SPECIAL PERMITS TO MAINTAIN IN EXCESS OF THREE DOGS; PROHIBITS DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE OR TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY; PROVIDES FOR THE QUARANTINE OF BITING ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR THE DESIGNATION OF A POUNDKEEPER AND THE IM-POUNDMENT OF ANIMALS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS FOR IMPOUNDMENT, DESTRUCTION AND RELEASE OF ANIMALS; PROHIBITS THE KEEPING OF NOISY ANIMALS; PROVIDES FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF ALL DOGS ENDANGERING PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY, PUBLIC SAFETY, THEMSELVES, OR OTHER ANIMALS; PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO" BY PROVIDING FOR CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION RECEIVED BY THE ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Washoe County Ordinance No. 226 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section which shall read as follows:

SECTION 24. Notification of Animal Control Officer of violation of ordinance.

Any person who observes a violation of any provision of this ordinance may notify the Animal Control Officer of the violation either orally or by written communication. Such notification shall be for the sole use of the Animal Control Officer and the name and address of the person providing such notification shall remain confidential unless:

- 1. Permission to disclose the name and address is given by that person to the Animal Control Officer;
- 2. Disclosure of the name and address of that person is required in any judicial proceeding.

SECTION 2. Existing sections 24 to 28, inclusive, of Washoe County Ordinance No. 226 are hereby renumbered as sections 25 to 29, inclusive.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 3}}.$ This ordinance shall take effect after its proposal, passage and publication as prescribed by NRS 244.100.
