SUMMARY: Amends the Washoe County Code to require gratuitous issuance of the Code to political subdivisions which provide the County with their Codes free of charge.

BILL NO. 744

ORDINANCE NO. 571

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WASHOE COUNTY CODE BY REQUIRING THE COUNTY CLERK TO ISSUE THE CODE, AND SUPPLEMENTS THERETO, TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS WHICH FURNISH THE COUNTY WITH THEIR CODES AND SUPPLEMENTS FREE OF CHARGE.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Washoe County Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section which shall read as follows:

2.XXX Gratuitous issuance of code to political subdivisions on reciprocal basis.

1. The clerk shall issue codes, including covers, to any political subdivision of the state which has furnished to the county free of charge the codes or compiled ordinances of that political subdivision. The number of codes issued shall equal the number of codes or compiled ordinances furnished at no cost by that political subdivision to the county, except that the clerk may issue a smaller number of codes to a political subdivision which does not request an equal number.

2. The clerk shall issue codes pursuant to subsection 1 at no cost to other political subdivisions.

SECTION 2. Section 9 of Washoe County Ordinance No. 561 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 9.

2.XXX Disbursement and sale of supplements by county clerk; proceeds to be deposited in general fund.

1. The head of the reproduction department shall, as soon as possible after completing the printing, punching and collating of a supplement, deliver all copies thereof to the clerk.

2. Upon receiving copies of a supplement to the code, the clerk shall attempt to notify by mail each entity or person who has previously purchased the code and does not have an annual subscription that the supplement may be purchased for the amount of \$7.50 at the office of the county clerk. Except as provided in subsections 3 and 4, supplements of the county code shall not be mailed to any entity or person.

3. The clerk shall provide for annual subscriptions

to supplements to the code at a price of \$15.00. The clerk shall mail supplements printed during the year of subscription to every entity or person who has purchased an annual subscription for that year.

4. The clerk shall mail, at the expense of the clerk, two copies of each supplement to the librarian of the Nevada Supreme Court law library and a number of copies of each supplement to political subdivisions which is sufficient to maintain every code furnished gratuitously pursuant to this chapter. No charge shall be made for such supplements.

5. The clerk shall keep all money received pursuant to this subsection in the general fund of the county.


