

SUMMARY: Adds basic power to furnish recreational facilities to basic powers of Sun Valley General Improvement District.

ORDINANCE NO. 1418

AN ORDINANCE ADDING THE BASIC POWER TO FURNISH RECREATIONAL FACILITIES TO THE BASIC POWERS GRANTED TO THE SUN VALLEY GENERAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF WASHOE DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Washoe does hereby find in granting the power set forth in section 3 of this ordinance that:

1. Public convenience and necessity require the grant of that power;
2. The grant of the additional power is economically sound and feasible;
3. The service plan as modified by the addition of the basic power conforms to subsection 1 of NRS 308.030; and
4. The service plan as amended by the basic power does not controvence any other criteria enumerated in subsection 1 of NRS 308.060

SECTION 2. At a hearing held on July 14, 2009 in regard to the addition of the basic power set forth in section 3, the board determined that 44 protests were filed and that those protests represent less than a majority of the owners of property within the Sun Valley General Improvement District.

Section 3. The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Washoe does hereby grant to the Board of Trustees of the Sun Valley General Improvement District the additional basic power to furnish recreational facilities as more particularly described in NRS 318.143.
