I am sending this email to register my opposition to the name change of E 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Feemster St. My elderly mother resides at 1411 E 10<sup>th</sup> Street since 1962. It is both a financial and physical hardship for my mother to avail herself to such an onerous change of her documents, DMV identification, etc. Due to the "real ID" process my mother would have to go to DMV to change her identification as it cannot be done electronically. Her ID address must match various social security documents, military spouse benefits etc....

I just ordered checks for my mother, because she still uses checks to pay her bills, it's the little things have been established for years that will be affected.

Please do not create this hardship for fixed income lower wage residents of this street.

This change is not only unreasonable for her but several other elderly neighbors who no longer drive but have been property owners on this street as well. It is unconscionable for this body to impose upon us this task during the severity of the pandemic in Washoe County. I take great pains to not expose my mother to COVID by unnecessary trips outside of her home to limit her exposure to persons who are not in our bubble.

This is in no way to disrespect the Feemster family we have been long time neighbors and friends. I feel this community should show more respect towards someone of her stature than renaming a street that only we residents use and will not in anyway expose the greater community to the respect this family deserves. I have lived in this community my entire life, and I cannot think of any "major" thoroughfare that is named for any person of color, and this family deserves that if any honor is to be bestowed upon them, not a residential neighborhood street.

Attached you will find letters and petition from neighbors on E 10<sup>th</sup> Street in opposition to changing the name to Feemster Street. Since the July 15<sup>th</sup> meeting, I have canvassed the street and left copies of the minutes from the July 15<sup>th</sup> meeting with a letter how to contact the committee or myself to register their support or opposition. Unfortunately, I will be out of the state on vacation at the time of the meeting, so I am submitting this as my testimony. I will try and call in if I have WI-fi available.

In talking to these neighbors all want to join in honoring the family and came up with a compromise they wanted to propose to the committee. The bottom half of E 10<sup>th</sup> Street has a natural break that dead ends into Sage Street and could be renamed only affecting one resident at 1895 E 10<sup>th</sup> Street. In looking at the assessors' map, there is a break in addresses from 1491 to 1895. What they would like to propose is to rename the portion of E 10<sup>th</sup> Street from Sage Street to Butler Street. That portion of E 10<sup>th</sup> Street intersects with these streets and would need street signs replaced as following: Feemster/Sage; Feemster/Barstow; Feemster/Goldfield; Feemster/Manhattan; Feemster/Butler. This portion of E 10<sup>th</sup> Street runs along the back side of Traner Jr High School and Mineral Manor housing. In reviewing the assessors map only one residence would be impacted and I attempted to contact the owners several times with no answer. The residents feel this is a win-win for all involved.

In speaking to the residents of the street, who I could, I found several things. Some who were renters had not heard from their landlords of the change and the only information they had was from my letter and the minutes of the meeting I provided. Several signed a letter opposing, others did not care, and three were in the process of moving out and did not care either way. One house is owned by the county and the one next door the owner has abandoned and has boarded it up. I contacted her as her family is a long term resident and she said since her mother passed she has not lived on the property and didn't care either way.

The next group were homeowners, some long term others not. Most who were homeowners did not know why there was a request to change and some thought it was already a done deal and were surprised from reading the minutes they had a say in the process. I explained who the Feemster family was and their contributions to the community was the impetus to the change to honor them. The elderly neighbors, (most of which know the family) were the most reticent to change of the street name. Talking to a number of these residents was a challenge as English is their second language. I was fortunate to have a friend who was bi-lingual talk to these residents and as you see I did my petition in both English and Spanish.

A number of residents have home based businesses, ranging from a mobile food truck, lawn care, group home and one has a corporation that does services. Some of the reasons residents and home owners did not want to change, ranged from not only personal things like drivers' licenses and registrations, but also changing businesses with state, federal and local governments during this pandemic is problematic financially and time consuming. For example, DMV even with an appointment can take hours. The

person who has a corporation also has a trust and would cost her legal fees to contact her attorney to make business changes.

I found out after the fact, that Ms. Feemster and Councilman Delgado had a "street fair" over the labor day weekend at Traner Middle School. I asked all the neighbors who I spoke to if they were aware of the function and if they attended. None of the residents on E 10<sup>th</sup> Street I spoke to were aware of this function and did not attend. I found out after the fact because I have mutual friends who attended and posted to their FB pages the next day. As a community event, it appears to have been a community wide success, but again, none of the people who are being directly impacted, knew of this event. Also, as of this date none have heard from Councilman Delgado or anyone wishing to change the name of the street.

Some of the long term neighbors agree with my original statement that naming our neighborhood street is just a small token of recognition, something that would be a community large recognition is more worthy of honor to this family, examples like the Evelyn Mount Center, Willie Wynn apartments, etc. There appears to be significant community support for this honor, hopefully Councilman Delgado can find a more consequential location for this honor since he is also personally involved, that will not have a financial and personal hardship on individuals.


In closing, I have forwarded written petitions I received by going door to door. Some residents have said they preferred to e-mail the committee directly their support or opposition. Again, I would like to reiterate all the residents I spoke to once they learned of why the family was to be honored agree with doing something and hope the compromise we put forward in the previous statement will be honored. This neighborhood is a working class and fixed income neighborhood and the pandemic weighs heavily in all their dealings. I heard numerous times, I can't afford to take time off from work to change things, to I cannot afford to pay for what this address change will cost me. Elderly residents have transitioned to having prescriptions mailed to them, groceries delivered and depend on their address more than they have in the past because of COVID and did not want anything to cause a disruption to these services.
