

# SWAN LAKE & SILVER LAKE FLOOD COMMUNITY CLEANUP

JUNE 23 & 30 FROM 8A.M. TO 12:30P.M.

Join us as we work together to clean up sandbags and other flood protection materials from the Swan Lake and Silver Lake areas.

## - RESIDENTS -

Residents have asked for cleanup assistance and we are here to help with three possible options. **Sign up with Washoe311 by calling 3-1-1 or 775-328-2003 no later than June 20.**

**Option 1:** Bring sandbags and flood related debris to one of three specified locations

- North Location: Lemmon Drive and Pompe Way
- South Location: Lemmon Valley Park Parking Lot
- East Location: Lemmon Valley Volunteer Fire Station

**Option 2:** Move sandbags/materials near the street (but not in street) for pick up. Homeowner must reserve a spot with Washoe311, but is not required to be present.

**Option 3:** We will remove materials from your property. Homeowner must reserve a spot with Washoe311, be present during the cleanup & sign a right of entry to allow volunteers on the property.

*\*Clean up only for sandbags and other flood protection materials please.*
