



WHAT HAS BEEN DONE

Washoe County and the North Valleys Incident Command Team are working with regional partners and have provided the following:

Sand and sandbags

- 1,126 cubic yards of sand
- 150,000 sand bags

Signage

- 66 metal signs
- 63 type II barricades
- 26 type III barricades
- 1 reader board at Pompe and Lemmon Dr.

Road stability and drainage

- 856 cubic yards of 3-inch minus rock
- 489 cubic yards of road grindings for road stability
- 27,000 square feet of geotextile fabric for roads
- 80 linear feet of 8-inch PVC pipe

Man hours

In all, more than 1,600 hours have been dedicated to Lemmon Valley flood efforts, including:

- 470 hours for flood control
- 57 hours for ditch cleaning
- 75 hours for debris removal
- 33 hours for pipe cleaning
- 14 hours for stockpile sand
- 16.5 hours for road sweeping
- 21 hours for shoulder repair
- 43.5 hours for inspection/coordination
